London Underground's Piccadilly Line provides the most cost-effective rail route between Heathrow Airport and the capital. Journey time by Tube is under an hour and you shouldn't have to wait longer than ten minutes for a train, even off-peak.

Where to catch underground trains

Heathrow has three London Underground stations – one for Terminals 1, 2 and 3, one each at Terminal 4 and Terminal 5. Heathrow Terminals 1, 2, 3 station is in the central area between the terminals, which are a few minutes' walk away via underground walkways. Heathrow Terminal 4 and Heathrow Terminal 5 underground stations are in the basements of the terminal buildings.

Fares and tickets

Underground tickets are available at all stations. All Heathrow stations are in Travelcard Zone 6. The single fare to central London (Zone 1) is £5.70. A one-day Travelcard, giving unlimited travel in Zones 1 - 6, costs £17 (Anytime) or £8.90 (off-peak). London has an excellent public transport system, Google Maps can help you to find directions in London, including from London airports and train stations as the public transport information is available through the directions function.





Leave underground station and head north on Wandsworth Road (towards Vauxhall Bridge). Continue straight on Wandsworth Road for 550m and turn right onto Albert Embankment. The hotel is at 18 Albert Embankment.


Nearest underground/train station:

Head northwest on Westminster Bridge Road towards Baylis Road. Take a sharp left onto Kennington Road and continue for 31m. Turn right onto Hercules road and walk for 400m. Turn right onto Lambeth Road. The hotel will be approximately 280m down the road, on the left.

Estimated journey time = 9 minutes walk






Directions to Dinner Venue


Dinner on 5 November 2014 is at:


