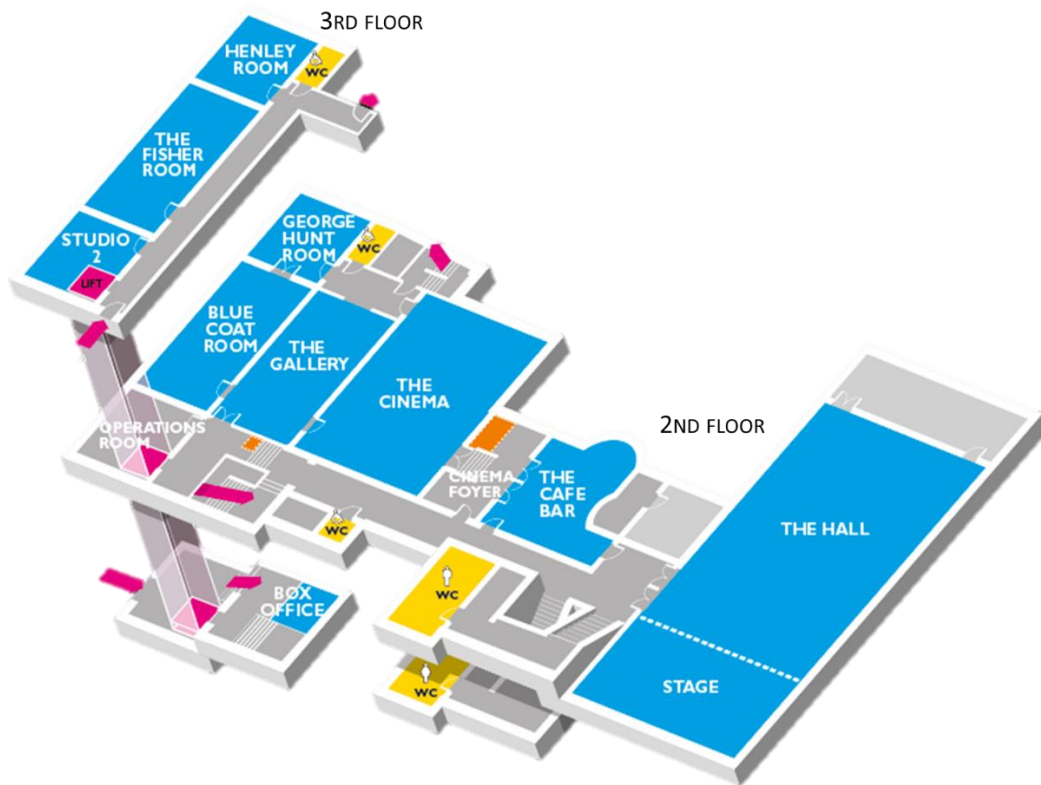
Participants are kindly reminded that the standard electrical voltage is 230 V, the standard frequency is 50 Hz, and the power sockets are of type G.
