## Arrival and transport

Participants are kindly requested to make their own international and local travel arrangements.

### *From Schiphol Airport*

From Schiphol Airport there are several direct trains to the two stations of The Hague: The Hague Central Station (Den Haag Centraal) and The Hague HS (Den Haag Hollands Spoor). The journey to The Hague takes approximately 40 minutes by train. [Schiphol railway station](#) is situated directly below the airport. Tickets are available from the yellow vending machines. Please note that tickets purchased from the ticket offices, situated close to the red/white-checked cube at Schiphol Plaza, include a service fee.

### *From Rotterdam The Hague Airport*

Bus number 33 goes from [Rotterdam The Hague Airport](#) to the Meijersplein stop in Rotterdam. From there participants may take a direct metro connection (metro line E) to Den Haag Centraal station. The bus journey takes approximately 6 minutes and the metro journey approximately 26 minutes. Tickets for both the bus and the metro can be obtained from the AKO shop at Rotterdam The Hague Airport.

### *From The Hague Central Station*

There is a 1.5-km walk from the central station to NVAO's office. Alternatively, participants may take bus from the bus station located one floor above the train station. Take bus 22 (direction: Duindorp) or bus 24 (direction: Kijkduin) and get off at the stop "Mauritskade". From the bus stop, there is approximately a 100-meter walk to NVAO's office.

### *From The Hague Hollands Spoor Station*

There is a 2-km walk from the station to NVAO's office. Alternatively, participants may take tram 1 (direction: Scheveningen Noorderstrand) from outside the train station and get off at the stop "Mauritskade". From the tram stop, there is approximately a 100-meter walk to NVAO's office.

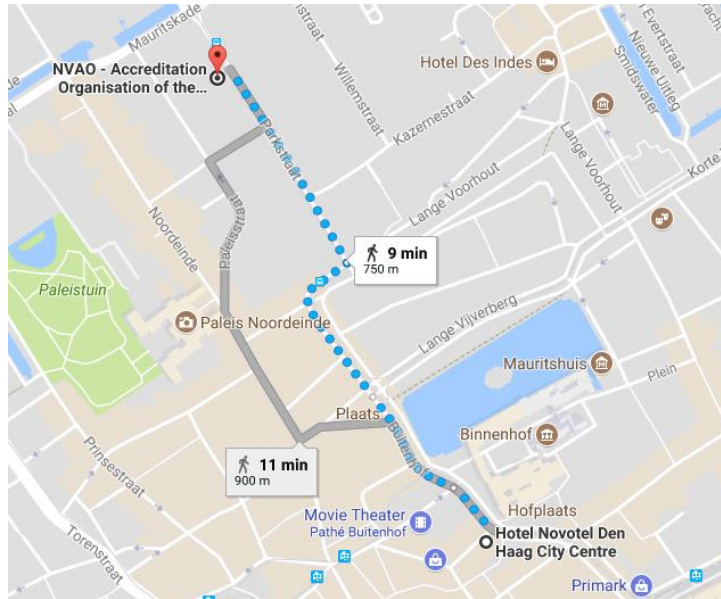
