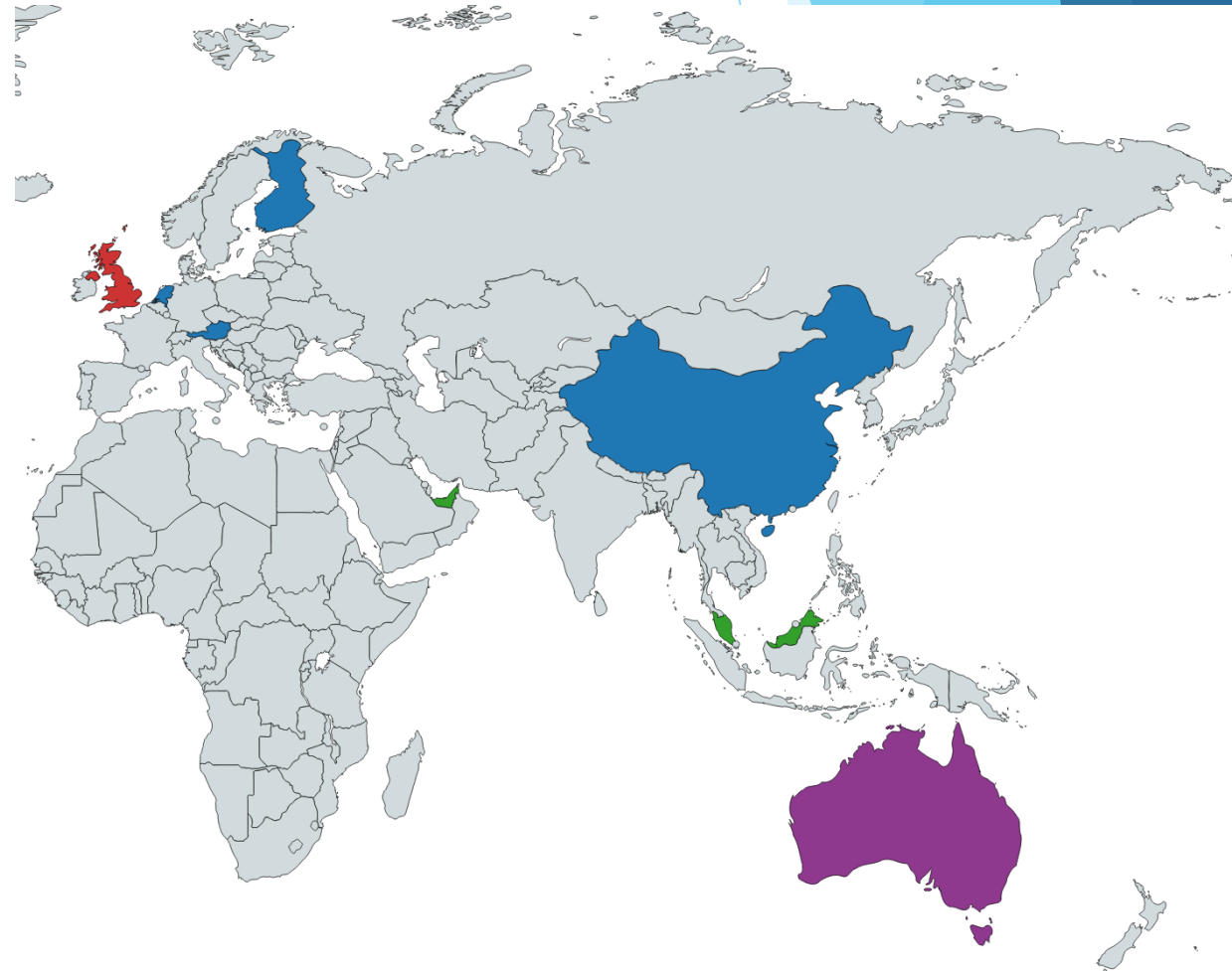

- ▶ Time commitments
- ▶ Experience
- ▶ Finances
