Subject: Follow-up report to the 2014 external review


Dear Mr. Reschauer,

At its meeting on 15 June 2016, the ENQA Board considered the follow-up report arising from the external review of AHPGS in 2014. The Board acknowledged the improvements achieved and expressed its satisfaction with the progress that has been made.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that as the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG 2015) were adopted in the Ministerial Conference in May 2015, we expect that all ENQA Members have by now incorporated ESG 2015 into all relevant procedures.

In this regard, the Board urges AHPGS to put specific attention to Standard 3.4 Thematic analysis. It will be carefully looked at in the next review as in ESG 2015 it is now explicitly formulated that thematic analyses should be regularly carried out and published by agencies.
