
**Subject: Follow-up report to the 2014 external review report**

Dear Mr. Cinquegrani,

At its meeting on 28 April 2016, the ENQA Board considered the follow-up report arising from the external review of AVEPRO in 2014.

The Board acknowledged the improvements made and expressed its satisfaction with the progress that has been achieved. At the same time the Board considers that there is an urgent need for AVEPRO to revise its evaluation methodology, and to support academic institutions in reflecting upon and implementing the new expectations concerning the ESG 2015. AVEPRO is encouraged to accelerate its efforts to fulfil expectations of the new ESG, conscious of the fact that it contains several areas to work on (especially concerning student-centredness in higher education; linkages between external quality assurance and fair recognition according to the Lisbon Recognition Convention; professionalism and accountability).
