23.10.2024 afternoon and evening- Valletta UNESCO Capital City

15:30 to 16:30 - The social event shall kick off with the Presentation by the Malta Further and Higher Education Authority on the Maltese higher Education system. The presentation will be held at the Ballroom, at the Marriott Resort and Spa.

16:30 - Following the presentation delegates will proceed to the Hotel's Foyer where they will board specifically assigned buses which will take them to Valletta for the second part of the social event.

17:00 to 18:45 – Delegates will be greeted in Valletta by professional tour guides who will take them on a walking tour around the Capital City. Valletta is a fortified city located on a hilly peninsula between two of the finest natural harbours in the Mediterranean. Built by the Order of the Knights of St. John, Valletta was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Centre in 1980. Comfortable walking shoes are highly recommended.

19:00 – 21:30 – The evening will end with a welcome reception at MUŻA. MUŻA stands for Mużew Nazzjonali ta' I-Arti which translates to English as National Museum of Art . Set within Auberge D'Italie, which was built in 1580, the museum acts as a showcase to local talent where traditional contemporary and modern art blend harmoniously with the museum's permanent displays which were carefully located to capture the narrative of the building. MUŻA seeks to push the boundaries of a traditional museum and holds the ideal setting for just such an event. Transport back to the Marriot will be provided by organiser.

19:00 – 22:00 lż-Żifna Folklore Dinner - Cala Lido – Marriott Resort & Spa

The evening will open with Iż-Żifna which translates to English as the Dance. The Paul Curmi Folklore Dancers will offer you a glimpse into Maltese life back in the nineteenth century. The show will be followed by a lavish buffet dinner served by the poolside.

Taxi services between Malta Airport and any destination in Malta are available 24 hours a day. Pre-paid service can be purchased at fixed rates from the booth available at the airport Arrivals' Hall. Alternatively, you may book your rides directly through the Malta Taxi app, or alternatively Bolt, Uber or eCABS apps which are available on both Google Play and the App Store.

b. **By local public transportation**:

9. GENERAL INFORMATION

Malta

Malta is an island country consisting of an archipelago and is situated in the Mediterranean Sea. The official languages are Maltese and English. The country joined the European Union in 2004; it became part of the eurozone monetary union in 2008. Malta is a tourist destination with its warm climate, numerous recreational areas, and architectural and historical monuments, including three UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

9.1 St Julian's

The ENQA General Assembly is going to be held in St Julian's. St Julian's is located on the NE of the island of Malta and it is mostly famous for is mostly buzzing laid back social life. Originally a fishing village the village evolved into a touristic destination and a hub for new and luxurious hotels, and many different kinds of bars, pubs and restaurants. It also boast 3 beaches; Balluta, Spinola and St George's Bay. It is also just 10 minutes on foot away from Sliema.

9.2 Official Language

The official languages of Malta are Maltese and English. Italian is also widely spoken.

9.3 Weather

The Maltese weather is greatly influenced by the Mediterranean climate. In October temperatures vary between 18° and 25° Celsius. There may be a slight drop in temperature, particularly in the evenings.

9.4 Time

In October, Malta's time zone is Central European Time (CET, GMT+1)

9.5 Electricity

The electrical supply is 230 Volts/-10%. The frequency of the supply is 50 Hertz.

The three-pin rectangular plug system is used, as in Britain. Adapters may be bought at the convenience store located just outside Arrivals at the airport or from any ironmongery store.

9.6 Water

Tap water is safe to drink throughout the Maltese Islands. Alternatively, one can buy local or imported bottled water from shops or restaurants.

9.7 Smoking

Indoor smoking is prohibited in public places in Malta. Some bars, restaurants, theatres, museums, and other public places have designated areas for smoking.

9.8 Credit cards and currency or ATMs

The currency used in Malta is the Euro. Most credit cards are accepted in hotels, restaurants, stores, etc. Visa and MasterCard are accepted almost everywhere. However, some restaurants and small shops accept only cash.

Currency exchange offices are located at the airports, and as well in the hotels.
